

We host events all year, from our flagship event, Weekend for Good, to day-long workshops, professional development days and networking events.

Weekend for Good

Our signature three-day event harnesses the brainpower, technical horsepower, and creative know-how of 80–100 volunteers to help 10–12 non-profit organizations by developing custom-tailored solutions to maximize their outreach. From websites and database solutions to design and branding work, copywriting and marketing strategy, Weekend for Good helps the organizations that better our community.

Code for Good is dedicated to fostering a more inclusive and equitable West Michigan. We actively seek partnerships with community-based organizations and diverse sponsors and nonprofits to advance our mission.

Lead for Good

We believe in the importance of leadership and its power to cultivate a forward-thinking, adaptive, and resilient mindset. Lead for Good is a series of panel discussions focused on more than design and technology but also the emotional intelligence and soft skills needed to become a proven leader in any field. Panels include many of West Michigan's most respected leaders.

Workshops for Good

Workshops for Good are single-day hands-on events that help local non-profits quickly develop solutions for projects that are too small in scope for Weekend for Good. Projects range from web design and backend development to social media and marketing strategy and so much more

The Value of Doing Good

It's estimated that building a fully functional website for a non-profit organization can cost \$20,000. Since 2007, our volunteers have given \$4 million in billable time to non-profit Weekend for Good participants.

But we're about more than websites. Our core value is ensuring equitable access to technology in its myriad forms. Our programs work towards bridging the digital divide, leveling the accessibility playing field and creating inclusive solutions for underserved communities throughout West Michigan.
